- NAWBO will follow [CDC](#) and all applicable state and local regulations for COVID protocol at the event
- The [city of Louisville](#) does not have a mask mandate in place nor does The Galt House
- The Galt House provides hand sanitizer stations throughout their property and high traffic hotel areas are cleaned more often than low traffic areas
- Each event attendee is required to sign a NAWBO event release waiver either electronically or onsite at the registration area prior to entering the event
- NAWBO is not requiring event attendees to wear masks at the event, however anyone who would feel more comfortable wearing a mask is welcome to do so
- Masks and COVID tests will be available for those who would like to test themselves or wear masks
- NAWBO is offering color-coded bracelets so participants can signal their comfort level with personal interactions
 - Red – Social distancing is preferred
 - Yellow – Fist bump only please
 - Green – Hug it out
